Summary & Future Plans

Summary

Q: Provide a brief self-evaluation of your performance over the past year in the areas of research, teaching, and service.

A: Research: I continue to strive to publish work in top-tier journals. In 2023, I had a paper published in the Journal of Accounting & Economics, another paper published in the Review of Accounting Studies, and still another paper published in The Accounting Review! Further, another paper was conditionally accepted in the Review of Accounting Studies (publication likely in 2024). So, it was a stellar research year! Aside from these papers, I have four active working papers, one of which is Revise and Resubmit at Contemporary Accounting Research. Also, in 2023 I started one new project (still work in process) with a Utah junior faculty member and a Utah Ph.D. student. My total citation count continues to grow (from approximately 1,100 citations at the end of 2022 to over 1,300 citations at the end of 2023 per Google Scholar), which encourages me that my work is continuing to have an increasing impact. Finally, I was pleased to be recognized in 2023 with a David Eccles Faculty Fellowship.

Teaching: In Spring 2023 I taught two sections of Business Valuation (ACCTG 6620) in addition to an empirical Ph.D. seminar. In Fall 2023 I transitioned to teaching introductory-level Financial Accounting in both the full-time MBA and Executive MBA programs, while also teaching an additional section of Business Valuation. So, 2023 was very teaching heavy because I switched from Spring to Fall teaching (thus, I needed to teach the entire calendar year). However, I cherish the opportunity to teach our MBA and EMBA students (a student population I am very comfortable with), which is a return to what I was teaching at my previous institution (Emory). Of course, I expect it to take another iteration or two of teaching these new classes to really make them my own. All in all, I think I was successful, as I received positive feedback from the students and related program offices.

Service: My primary service role internally continues to be the Accounting Ph.D. Program Director, which consumes a great deal of time. In 2023, I led an effort that restructured our four-course empirical accounting Ph.D. seminar sequence, which will provide us with much more flexibility and adaptability in the curriculum going forward. One byproduct of this role is that I continue to serve on numerous Ph.D. student supervisory and dissertation committees, both in accounting and finance. Also, my role on the Accounting Department RPT Committee involves a significant time investment (i.e., formal and informal faculty reviews). I also continued to serve meaningful service roles in the profession in 2023, including refereeing for top journals and serving on the editorial board of The Accounting Review. Finally, in 2023 I agreed to serve as Chair-Elect for the American Accounting Association's Global Emerging Scholars Research Workshop, which involves research mentorship of junior faculty at lower-tier schools around the world. All in all, I would give myself a good grade for my service contributions.
